****Tour to Kantishna-The best tour of Denali!!**

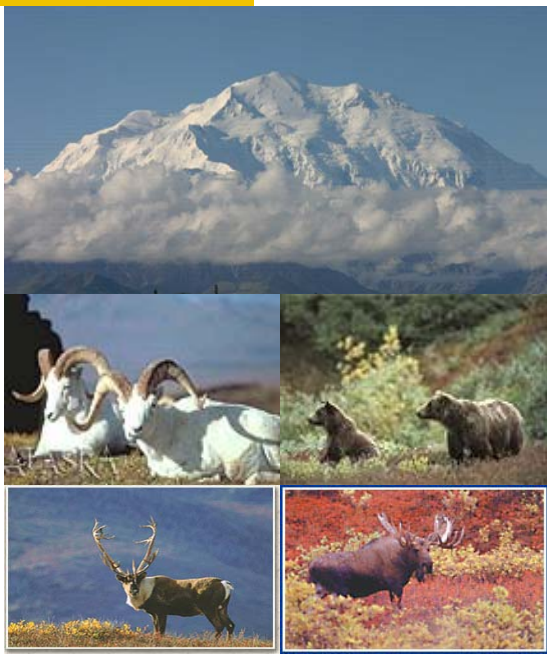

DENALI JEEP® BACKCOUNTRY SAFARI Take the wheel and follow your guide on a spectacular off-road journey on the Stampede trail. Interactive two-way radios allow your guide to interpret the area. You will stop for a break at a wilderness camp where you can enjoy a small "wilderness" cooked meal. Duration: 3.5 hours

We travel a meandering 30 miles round trip, crossing two glacial streams, up past the timberline to the alpine tundra into the Alaska Range. The history of the settlers and area come alive as we follow the trail used by early explorers. Bring a lunch for a picnic in the wilderness.

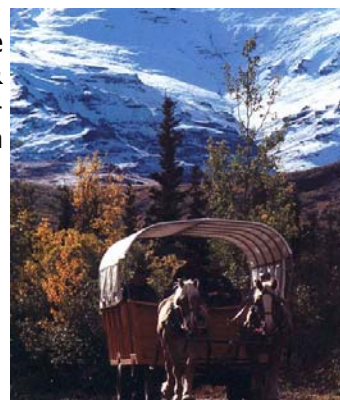


***Horse Drawn Wagon Ride with a delicious camp meal**

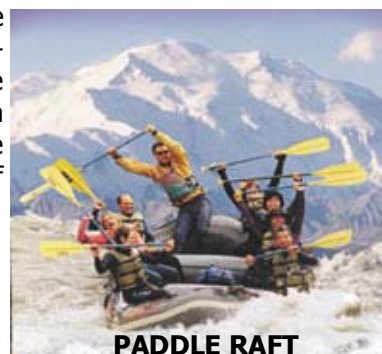

This is a moderate ride for those with basic skills and reasonable fitness. Age 10+.

DENALI HORSEBACK RIDES

Explore Denali the way few others see it! Denali Saddle Safaris offers guided rides into the wilderness surrounding Denali National Park.

1Hr. Taiga Tour-This ride winds through the boreal forest at the tree line boundary with the tundra. It offers great 360 degree views & an integrative natural history lecture. Our only complaint is that it's over too quickly. Elevations are around 2000 ft., there are great wildflower, berry & wildlife viewing opportunities.

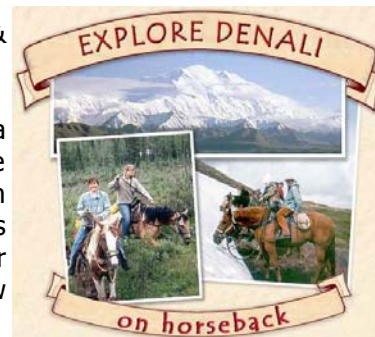
2 Hr. Tundra Tour-This is the perfect ride for those who want a real taste of Alaska but who don't want to brave four hours in the saddle. Your savvy horse will carry you up the open tundra to an elevation of 2500 ft. and return through a beautiful ravine that melds into taiga. Amazing views will have you constantly reaching for your camera. Excellent natural history lectures and great chances to view wildlife, especially moose!

1/2 Day Alpine Tour-You and your sturdy mountain horse will ascend a 3800-foot ridge overlooking the Healy drainage and the National park. Ride up into pure alpine terrain where 100-year old trees are only 6 inches tall! This ride offers astounding views of the "The Great One"-Denali a.k.a. Mt. McKinley. This tour covers it all-taiga, tundra, the alpine-from wildflowers to marmots, moose and bears. Snack provided, if you can eat it before your horse does, it's their favorite treat.

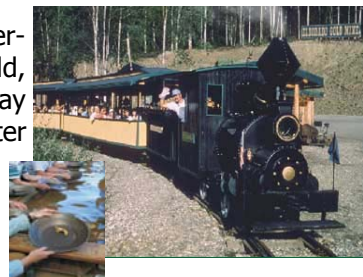
